The School Bus Transport Code of Conduct is written to ensure your safety and the safety of your fellow passengers. In signing up to use the School Bus you are accepting the North Bridge House School Transport Code of Conduct:

- I will arrive at my stop 5 minutes before the bus
- I will approach the bus only after it has come to a complete stop
- I will take care when getting on and off the bus and will not push
- I will not reserve seats or ask others to reserve a seat for me
- I will not change seats during the entire bus journey
- I will remain seated at all times when inside the school bus
- I will not stand up in my seat until the bus has come to complete stop and told to do so
- I will wear my seat belt at all times when inside the school bus
- I will not tease or threaten others
- I will not push, pull or hit others
- I will not use bad language or swearing
- I will not eat or drink on the school bus
- I will not drop litter on the school bus
- I will not discuss topics that others may find upsetting or offensive
- I understand that mobile phones are to be used for contacting parents/carers and in emergencies only
- I will respect my driver and chaperone
- I will follow the instructions of the bus driver and chaperone



- If I misbehave I understand that the driver or chaperone may ask me to sit at the front of the school bus
- I will try not to make sudden loud noises nor throw any objects which can distract the driver
- I will be ready to get on the coach in the afternoon and will not be able to return to school once the teacher has escorted me to the school bus
- I will be ready to get off the bus at my stop
- I will check that I have taken all my belongings from the school bus in the morning and afternoon
- I must use headphones if I would like to listen to music on the coach
