How to apply

To apply for a place at North Bridge House Cannothury please complete and return a Registration Form (available on the school website), together with the Registration Fee required of external applicants. The Admissions Team will then contact you to confirm receipt of your application and to arrange for your child to join us for an Admissions Day, Applicants for all year groups, from Year to Sokh Form, are assessed to determine their current academic level and how we can best help them full their potential. A Level applicants will require at least 5 GCSEs at C grade or above, with a minimum of a B grade in the subjects they wish to study in Year 12. They will also have an intensive with the Head of Department for each subject they wish to study and with a member of the Senior Leadership Team to ensure they are suited to – and will be happy at – North Bridge House. Further to the Admissions Day places are offered as soon as possible, depending on availability. With the introduction of Year 7 in September 2017, our maintake points are at 11+ and 16+ however, we continue to welcome and consider applicants for Year 9 and occassionally other year groups. Cognita Branding

Correct usage throughout school materials

Cognita is a global leader in independent education that is committed to enriching the lives of children to achieve more than they believe they can. These guidelines specify how Cognita's key messages and branding elements should be applied when schools wish to incorporate text about Cognita into their own promotional literature and/or parent communications.

Whilst each school's branding and key messages will always be the most prominent aspect of school communications, it will be necessary at times to refer to the Cognita Group and provide some context as to Cognita's size, activity and education values.

Consistency is therefore critical. We do not intend to be overly prescriptive about the way copy is written however, there are some core messages that should be referenced when describing Cognita in broad terms and these are included below.

Please note that we avoid using 'network' to describe Cognita. Rather we are a 'group' or 'family' of schools, each one individual, no two the same.


