Across five North London school sites, we successfully prepare happy pupils for every milestone, with specialist expertise at each school stage from the important early years through to the challenging teenage ones.

All staff members across the North Bridge House group are dedicated to our three brand pillars: 1. Knowing the individual, 2. Fostering academic excellence, 3. Cultivating character and promoting wellbeing. At whichever school stage families join North Bridge House, we pride ourselves on really getting to know each individual pupil on their journey from Nursery through to Sixth Form. It is only through knowing the individual that we can truly help each child to achieve their full potential, both academically and personally.

North Bridge House Prep School, the landmark building on Gloucester Avenue, is just a stone's throw from the beautiful Regent's Park and caters for pupils aged 7 to 13, supporting them through the North London Girls' School Consortium and 11+ testing or the boys' 13+ Common Entrance process.

Prep School Curriculum

North Bridge House Prep School provides a rich and varied curriculum which is both challenging and rewarding for every pupil. Designed to stretch pupils further than in a junior school setting, the Prep School curriculum takes pupils beyond the general knowledge of a subject and equips them with a deeper understanding of its more advanced concepts.

Recognised for having an excellent command of their teaching material across a full range of subjects, teachers carefully plan and deliver lessons to address individual learning needs and thus pupils are highly successful whatever their starting points.

Pupils in the Lower School – Years 3 and 4 – are taught by class teachers for the majority of their subjects, with specialists delivering Art, Drama, Music, Languages and Physical Education. From Year 5 to Year 8, pupils are taught entirely by subject specialists and prepared for various different senior school entrance examinations. We advise on and facilitate pupils either leaving the Prep School at the end of Year 6 (taking the 11+, the Consortium exam or going to one of the North Bridge House Senior Schools), or at the end of Year 8 (taking the Common Pre-Test exam, the Common Entrance exam or schools' individual entrance tests). Pupils are prepared for the best school according to their individual strengths and interests, often gaining highly competitive scholarship places and academic awards.



Extra-Curricular & Enrichment

At North Bridge House Prep School we are committed to celebrating the individual, including their many talents and interests beyond the curriculum. We offer a wide range of after school clubs and activities which encourage personal growth and develop all-important self-confidence.


From Music, Drama and Art, which children enjoy as both subject and enrichment offerings, to the more niche clubs such as Chess and Flamenco, our extra-curricular programme is rich, diverse and character-building.

We are proud to boast multiple choirs, an orchestra, and the popular 'Singer Songwriter' club, and as such, enjoy a wonderful host of concerts throughout the school year. Children also take great pride in producing and performing in school theatre productions, contributing behind the scenes as well as on stage.

There are plenty of other creative and sporting opportunities in clubs such as Textiles, Cookery, Model-Making, Table Tennis, Street Dance and Ballet, to name but a few. All clubs build on the curriculum to ensure that each child not only receives an excellent all-round education, but has the opportunity to discover and pursue other areas of inspiration.

In addition to this, all pupils enjoy a broad range of memorable trips and visits throughout the year. Recent favourites have included cultural stays in France, Italy and Morocco, as well as excursions to the many great London museums in the surrounding area.

Residential camps such as Bushcraft and PGL are also highly popular with the children, who enjoy trying a range of watersports and learning survival skills.

At North Bridge House Prep School, pupils enjoy a wide range of sports as both part of and in addition to the curriculum. We believe that sport is essential to pupils' physical and emotional well-being and develops valuable team skills. Girls and boys benefit from weekly PE and Games sessions which are held in either Regent's Park or the school gym. Additional activities such as rock-climbing take place at local sports facilities, whilst winter cricket is played in our Senior School sports hall and at Lords. We enjoy competitive events in many of these sports, including House and School matches, local and national tournaments, as well as tours around the UK. There are also a number of events in which pupils across all year groups participate, such as the annual Football Tournament and Sports Day.

We endeavour to give as many of our pupils the chance to represent the school as possible, organising A, B and C teams amongst the majority of our sports squads.

Facilities

North Bridge House Prep School is a striking building which provides fantastic on-site facilities and is ideally located next to Regent's Park, where students enjoy recreational and regular sports sessions.

With its ornate ceiling in the chapel and stained-glass windows, the building hosts many impressive architectural features which hint at its former life as a convent. Now, together with the modern teaching facilities, the school's character creates an inspiring learning environment in which pupils benefit from the latest technology and advanced learning resources.

Bright, spacious classrooms are augmented by two large music rooms; soundproof music pods for one-to-one tuition, practice and recording; an indoor gym; state-of-the-art Science laboratories and an Art studio flooded with natural light. In addition, pupils enjoy the broad collection of library books both in and out of class time, as well as weekly I.T. lessons and extensive use of iPads.

Staff, pupils, parents and friends form a strong community at North Bridge House and together we support one another and the local area. From our many school events to the outreach projects and global charity initiatives in which we participate, there is plenty of opportunity for pupils and families to contribute to our vibrant community.

Where next?


Traditionally, girls are prepared for senior school 11+ assessments and boys for Common Entrance at 13+. The children that sit these external examinations all achieve outstanding results, with the majority of pupils gaining entry into their first choice Senior Schools – often with scholarships. These include some of the best Senior Schools in London and the UK, such as Channing, City of London, Mill Hill, North London Collegiate, South Hampstead, St. Paul's, UCS and Westminster. Prep School pupils can also continue their education at North Bridge House, and both girls and boys are welcomed into our two popular Senior School sites upon reference from the Head Teacher. We prioritise our Prep School children for places at either North Bridge House Senior Hampstead and North Bridge House Senior Canonbury, depending on their preference, and thus provide the ideal opportunity for students to complete their education without the added pressure of external entrance exams.

Importantly, all pupils are carefully advised on and prepared for the Senior School best suited to their needs, whether that is one of our sought after NBH campuses, or one of the other highly prestigious schools to which we are renowned for sending Prep School graduates.

How to apply

To apply for a place at North Bridge House Prep School, please complete a Registration Form on the school website and arrange payment of the registration fee via cheque or bank transfer with the Admissions Team. The Admissions Team will then contact you to confirm receipt of the application and to arrange for your child to join us for an Admissions Day. We are a non-selective school but assess potential students to determine their current academic level and how we can help them to fulfil their potential. Applicants also have an informal interview with the Head Teacher to ensure that they are suited to North Bridge House and, most importantly, that they will be happy at the school. Further to the Admissions Day places will be offered depending on availability. The main intake point is at 7+ however, we welcome applicants for all year groups.
