

NORTH BRIDGE HOUSE TRANSPORT: STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

The School Bus Transport Code of Conduct is written to ensure your safety and the safety of your fellow passengers. In signing up to use the School Bus you are accepting the North Bridge House School Transport Code of Conduct:

- I will arrive at my stop 5 minutes early and only approach the bus once it has come to a complete stop.
- I understand that I will not be able to return to school once the teacher has escorted me onto the bus.
- I will take care when getting on and off the bus, making sure I have taken all my belongings.
- I will not reserve seats or ask others to reserve a seat for me, nor will I change seats during the entire journey, **unless** the Chaperone has asked me to do so.
- I will always wear my seat belt as soon as I am on the bus.
- I will not tease or threaten others, nor will I push, pull or hit others and do anything that may distract the driver.
- I will not use bad/inappropriate language or swear.
- I will not eat or drink on the school bus or drop or leave any litter on the bus.
- I will not discuss topics that others may find upsetting or offensive
- I understand that mobile phones are to be used **only** for contacting parents/carers in an emergency.
- I understand that listening to any music requires headphones/ earphones.
- I will always respect my driver and chaperone and follow the chaperone's instructions.
